Mrs. Isackson Dies; Rites ^{8 Dec} In Missoula ¹⁹⁶⁹

Mrs. Anna Runsvold Isackson, 87, died in Kalispell Sunday evening.

Mrs. Isackson was born Feb. 9, 1882, in Norway, a daughter of Jonathan and Dorothea Runsvold.

As a child, she came to America and had settled at Sioux Falls, S. D. She later lived in Minnesota and North Dakota before moving to Kalispell in 1945. In 1955, she moved to Missoula for about three years when she returned to Kalispell and has been a resident of the Immanuel Lutheran Home for the past 11 years.

Mrs. Isackson was a member of the St. Paul's Lutheran Church of Missoula and was active in the affairs of the Immanuel Lutheran Home.

In about 1900, she was married to Jacob Isackson at Two Harbors, Minn., and was preceded in death by him in 1955. She was also preceded in death by one brother, Albert Runsvold, Jan. 3, 1967 and one sister, Mrs. Jennie Engebretson June 2, 1961.

She is now survived by one son, Robert Isackson of Washington, D. C.; two daughters, Mrs. William (Alice) Carlson and Mrs. Estella Hafer, both of Missoula; two sisters, Mrs. Carl Carlson of Moorhead, Minn., and Mrs. Clara Larson of Jackson, Minn.; one brother, Martin Runsvold of San Diego, Calif.; six grandchildren; two great-grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.

The body is being forwarded by the Johnson Funeral Home to the Squire-Simmons-Carr Funeral Home in Missoula where funeral services and interment are tentatively being planned for Wednesday afternoon.
